We have been busy with numerous projects!

- Patrolling in conjunction with our security partners (Humewood SAPS, F-ADT, Atlas and City Wide)
- Installation of CCTV cameras in vulnerable areas
- Bush clearing along the vulnerable areas and forming natural barriers to entry
- Patrolling the tip, as well as the Forest Hill Cemetery and engaging with the Nelson Mandela Bay Municipality to repair fences, gates and to remove Port Jackson Willow within the cemetery and on the outer perimeters.
- Together with the Nelson Mandela Bay Sanitation Department, over 300 bags of refuse were collected at a site previously occupied by the homeless. There is still a lot more to be done!
- Improving our technology platform for members and including the safety app (Buzzer) **FREE** to our members!

SSNW is a non-profit association, and all our efforts are focused on our community and is carried out by our volunteers. It is therefore very **IMPORTANT** that we remain sustainable in order to continue to provide a service and to implement our safety and security projects effectively.
